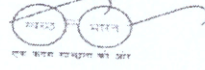


The Central Waqf Council in its 77th meeting dated 29th August, 2017 has decided that **Swachhata Week, in between 17th-25th September 2017**, may be observed by all State/UT Waqf Boards in their respective state under Swachh Bharat Mission.

In order to give an additional fillip to the spirit of "Swachhata", it is requested to organize cleanliness drives in the office(s) premises of the Waqf Board on any date in the week **17th-25th September 2017** convenient to the Waqf Board under intimation to Central Waqf Council, so that member of the Central Waqf Council attached with the zone will be present on the day of observance. Some of the activities that may be taken up as part of these drives may include:

1. Putting up "Swachhata" related themes.
2. Cleanliness drives at religious places and Waqf institutions with focus on waste management during this period.
3. Inspirational messages by religious icons to promote cleanliness.
4. Cleanliness drives in and around the Waqf Board's premises.
5. Weed out unused/old files, records and dispose of old/unused furniture/almirahs etc.
6. Planting of trees.
