**FREE COACHING & ALLIED SCHEME FOR THE CANDIDATES/STUDENTS BELONGING TO THE NOTIFIED MINORITY COMMUNITIES-INVITING PROPOSALS REGARDING.**

The Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India invites proposals from Institutions/Centers for providing Free Coaching to students/candidates belonging to the Minority Communities notified under section 2(c) of the national Commission for Minorities Act, 1992 namely Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhists, Zoroastrians (Parsis) for the following :

- a) Qualifying examinations for admission in technical/professional courses such as engineering, law, medical, management, information technology etc.
- b) Competitive examinations for recruitment to Group 'A', 'B' and 'C' services and other equivalent posts under the Central and State Governments including Public Sector Undertaking, Bank, Insurance Companies as well as autonomous bodies.
- c) Proposals relating to Coaching programmes only may be submitted.

2. The details of the scheme, including eligibility criteria for Coaching Institutes, stipend payable to candidates/students, fee payable to the coaching Institutes and application format etc. can be seen and downloaded from the website of the Ministry of Minority Affairs <http://minorityaffairs.gov.in>. The Institutes who have already applied in response to this Ministry's Advertisement dated 03.07.2013 for imparting coaching need not apply again.

3 Attention of applicants is invited to the following specific requirements:-

- (i) The institute should have the required number of qualified faculty members either on its pay roll or on part-time basis.
- (ii) The institutes should have necessary infrastructure such as premises, library, requisite equipment etc. to run the coaching classes /centers.
- (iii) The institutes should have experience in imparting coaching in the relevant course/programme for which it applies.

(iv) Coaching institutes should have a minimum success rate of 15%. A three year moving average could be considered for this purpose.

4. The Coaching Institutes in the private sector may submit their complete proposals in the prescribed application form (Part I and II) along with all necessary documents to the concerned Department of the respective State Government/Union Territory Administration dealing with Minority Welfare for onward transmission to the Director (SS), Room No. 1131, Ministry of Minority Affairs, 11<sup>th</sup> Floor, Paryavaran Bhavan, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi – 110003 **Institute in Government Sector/Public Sector Undertaking may submit their proposals directly at the above address.**

5. **Proposals received upto 13<sup>th</sup> December 2013 will be accepted.**
