(a) Indira Awas Yojana (IAY):

- (i) The State Government would ensure that the IAY houses would be distributed among BPL families from the approved waiting list, even if they belonged to communities other than the minority communities, strictly in order of their ranking in the list as per the IAY guidelines. Villages ranked highest on the basis of minority population in the 5 blocks were selected first and each block would be given 400 units each. State share would be provided.
- (ii) The list of the villages along with the number of houses to be constructed would be furnished by the State Government. To prevent duplication, the Government of Assam should ensure that the units funded under MsDP were reflected in the State Action Plan of the scheme and the Central Ministry concerned informed.

(b) Construction of ACRs with toilets in Government schools:

- (i) The State Government should ensure that the selection of schools would be made in the villages having highest concentration of minority population.
- (ii) State Government would provide a list of villages, where the ACRs and toilets for schools would be constructed, along with the proportion of minority population.
