3. Since it is fresh release, no UC is pending. Utilization Certificate for this grant should be submitted by the grantee in the prescribed format within 12 months of the closure of the financial year.

4. Utilisation of the above mentioned amount by the State Government is subject to the terms and conditioned at annexure-II.
