Subject: Grant in aid under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Multi sectoral Development Programme for minorities to Government of **Karnataka for the year 2009-10 for Gulbarga District.**

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President for release of an amount of Rs. 1,49,89,000 (**Rupees one crore forty nine lakhs and eighty nine thousand only**) as 1<sup>st</sup> instalment (50% of total central share) of the total sanctioned amount of Rs. 2,99,78,000 (**Rupees two crore ninety nine lakh and seventy eight thousand only**) for the year 2009-10 to the Govt. of Karnataka for implementing the scheme "Multi Sectoral Development Programme for minorities" for Gulbarga district as per the details enclosed at Annexure. The non-recurring grant may be released to the Govt. of Karnataka through CAS, Reserve Bank of India, Nagpur.

2. The expenditure is debitable to Demand No.66, Ministry of Minority Affairs Major Head- "3601" Grant-in-aid to State Government, 04- Grants for Central Plan Scheme (Sub Major Head), 378 -General- (Welfare of Schedule Casts/Schedule Tribes and Other Backward Classes) -other grants, 04 - Multi sectoral Development Programme for minorities, 04.00.31 - Grant-in-aid for the year 2009-10.

3. Utilization Certificate for this grant should be submitted by the grantee in the prescribed format within 12 months of the date of the Sanction Order.

4. The State Government should ensure that a board containing information of the date of sanction of the project, likely date of completion, estimated cost of the project, source of funding i.e. MsDP (Government of India), contractor(s) name and the physical target is displayed. After completion of projects, a permanent display would be installed.

5. This sanction issues with concurrence of IFD vide their Dy. No. 331/JS&FA(MA) dated 23.07.2009. It is noted at S.No. 11 in the Grant-in-aid Register.

**Indira Awas Yojana (IAY):**

- (i) State Government would ensure that the IAY houses would be constructed in villages with the highest minority concentration; BPL families would be selected from the approved waiting list, even if they belonged to communities other than the minority communities, strictly in order of their ranking in the list as per the IAY guidelines.
- (ii) It was stressed that no deviation from the guidelines was permitted.
- (iii) The list of the villages, indicating the number of houses to be constructed would be provided. State share would be provided.
- (iv) To prevent duplication, the Government of Karnataka would ensure that the units funded under MsDP were reflected in the State Action Plan of the scheme and information also sent to the Central Ministry concerned.



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
