- 3. Utilization Certificate for this grant should be submitted by the grantee in the prescribed format within 12 months of the date of the Sanction Order. As per the conditions contained in para 15.4 of the guideline of Multi sectoral Development Programme, (i) Quarterly Progress Report, (ii) Photographs of the works completed from earlier releases and (iii) work plan for the requisitioned amount may also be furnished along with the request for release of 2nd instalment of the grant.
- 4. The State Government should ensure that a board containing information of the date of sanction of the project, likely date of completion, estimated cost of the project, source of funding i.e. MsDP (Government of India), contractor(s) name and the physical target is displayed. After completion of projects, a permanent display would be installed.
- 5. This sanction issues with concurrence of IFD vide their Dy. No. 527/AS & FA (MA) dated 22.10.2009. It is noted at S.No.34 in the Grant-in-aid Register.
- 6. Re-appropriation of funds from the Major Head 2552 to functional Head 3601 have been carried out with the approval of Secretary (MA) as per his office diary No. 2264/Secy(MA)/09 dated 23.10.2009 for an amount of Rs. 4,15,00,000/- (Rupees four crore fifteen lakh only).

Indira Awas Yojana (IAY)

- (a) State Government would ensure that the IAY houses would be distributed among BPL families from the approved waiting list, even if they belonged to communities other than the minority communities, strictly in order of their ranking in the list as per the IAY guidelines.
- State share would be provided.
- (c) The list of the villages along with the number of houses to be constructed would be furnished by the State Government.
- (d) To prevent duplication the Government of Manipur should ensure that the units funded under MsDP were reflected in the State Action Plan of the scheme and the Central Ministry concerned informed.

Construction of labour room attached to the existing health sub-centres

- (a) State Government would saturate the sub-centres requirement in areas having the highest concentration of minority population,
- (b) NRHM construction norms, design, specification would be followed and State share would be provided,
- (c) List of villages where the sub-centres would be constructed would be furnished.
- (d) To prevent duplication the Government of Manipur would ensure that the health sub-centres funded under MsDP were reflected in the State Action Plan of the scheme and the Central Ministry concerned informed.
- (e) In order to achieve 100% institutional delivery as envisaged under NRHM, the State Government/NRHM Mission Director would ensure that corresponding consumables and staff was provided to such sub-centres.

Construction of Primary schools/Junior High School buildings

- (a) Villages having the highest minority concentration and those not covered under SSA would be selected
- (b) State Government would ensure that the cost for the construction of school building was as per the State Government's scheduled of rates and approved by the competent authority.
- (c) List of villages and their proportion of minority population where these schools would be constructed would be provided,
- (d) To prevent duplication the Government of Manipur should ensure that the schools funded under MsDP were reflected in the State Action Plan of the scheme and the Central Ministry concerned informed.

Drinking water facility

(a) The approved cost was as per ARWSP norms.

(b) Villages having the highest proportion of minority population, which are sourceless, would be selected.

(c) The list of the villages would be provided.

(d) To prevent duplication the Government of Manipur should ensure that the assets funded under MsDP were reflected in the State Action Plan of the scheme and the Central Department concerned informed.
